

**INNOVATIVE INITIATIVES UNDERTAKEN BY THE  
YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS DEPARTMENT**

One of the major innovative initiatives undertaken by the Youth Affairs & Sports Department is the launch of the Rural Sports Scheme.

The erstwhile Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan (RGKA) Scheme was replaced by the Khelo India Scheme. Under the Khelo India Scheme, Annual Sports Competitions are conducted from District Level upwards. This leaves the Gram Panchayats/Village Councils, Blocks and Sub-Divisions uncovered. The Rural Sports Scheme was introduced by the Government of Tripura in 2016 for holding Sports Competitions right from the grass-root level (Panchayat Level) up to the State Level. In 2016, overall participation in Rural Sports, 2016 is given below:
