ABSTRACT

Special Casual Leave to Junior Physical Instructors, Physical Instructors and Coaches - Streamlining of existing procedure - Modification order issued.

ORDER :

After careful consideration of the prevailing practice and the adverse impact of prolonged as well as intermittent absence of Junior Physical Instructors, Physical Instructors, Coaches, etc. from their places of work, it was laid down vide G.O. cited above that henceforth, an official of the above category would be allowed to enjoy 30 (thirty) days Special Casual Leave in a calendar year, for the following purposes only:

- (i) Attend coaching or training camps under Rajkumari Amrit Kaur Coaching Scheme or similar All India coaching or training scheme.
  - (ii) Attending coaching or training camps at the National Institute of Sports, Patiala.
  - (iii) Attending coaching camps in sports organized by the national sports federation / sports bodies recognized by the State Government or Central Government.
  - (iv) Such special casual leave would be admissible upto the maximum of 10 (ten) days in any year for participating in inter departmental tournaments and sporting events.
- Period of absence in excess of 30/10 days in a year would be treated as regular leave.

It has since been considered necessary to extend the services of Jr. Physical Instructors, Physical Instructors and Coaches of the Department to bodies affiliated to Tripura Sports Council for managing or coaching sports teams of such bodies sent outside the State. This measure will help in the promotion of sports and games in the State.

Taking into account this decision, it has also been decided that such deputation of Jr. Physical Instructors, Physical Instructors and Coaches will be eligible for sanction of Special Casual leave upto 30 days. Accordingly, the following clause is to be added after para. (iii) of G.O. No. 5 dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2002:

(iii) (a) : Managing or coaching any sports team outside the State, other than as a member of a team, on behalf of any affiliated body working on development / promotion of sports and youth activities in the State, subject to approval for such deputation by the Department and on merit in each case.

2. The order shall come into force from the date of issue.
